Child Passenger Safety Program

SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

- Infants should ride rear facing until age 1 and at least 20 pounds.
- Children over 1 year and at least 20 pounds may ride in a forward facing car seat until the harness no longer fits.
- Children should ride in a booster seat until they are at least 8 years old and/or 4' 9" tall.
- Children 12 and under should always ride in the back seat.
- Replace child safety seats that have been involved in a crash.
- Do not purchase a used child safety seat.

FITTING APPOINTMENTS

- Car seats and boosters are available twice a month, to district residents. Appointments are held the first and third Mondays of the month between the hours of 3-6pm at our Administration Center.
- Seats are provided to parents or legal guardians, who must be present to obtain the seat. Only one seat per child.
- The child receiving the seat must be present unless the baby is not born yet.
- The vehicle in which the child travels must be brought to the appointment.
- Parents/Guardians will be taught by a Certified Car Seat Technician to correctly install and use the seat.
