Home Fire Safety Program

Smoke Detectors & Fire Extinguishers

At the request of any District resident, a member of DHFD's Public Education Volunteer staff will make a home visit to offer fire safety information.

- During this visit a fire extinguisher will be provided and a smoke detector installed for the homeowner by the fire department representative.
- Residents will be reminded to check their smoke detectors every month and change the batteries every year and they will learn when and how to use a fire extinguisher.
- Home fire safety inspection information will also be provided to the resident.
